Day 01 MANILA / BEIJING

(D)

Assemble at the airport for your departure flight to **Beijing**. It was King Wu, who first declare Beijing - The Capital City in 1057 B.C. Beijing is an Independently administered municipal district, situated in the Northeastern part of China and covers a whole area of 16808 Sq. km. The climate in Beijing is of the continental Type, with cold and dry winters and hot summers. Upon arrival, meet by our local representative and transfer to the hotel for check in. Dinner will be provided. Overnight stay at **Novotel Xinqiao Beijing Hotel** or similar class.

Day 02 BEIJING – GREAT WALL, SUMMER PALACE, BIRD NEST, WATER CUBE, ACROBATIC SHOW

After breakfast at the hotel, we will begin our sightseeing tour with visit to the **Juyongguan Great Wall of China** with lunch provided at local restaurant. The construction of the Great Wall started in the 7th Century B.C. and the structure is said to be one of the two man made features on earth visible from the moon. It is also a magnificent piece of architecture aiding in China's defense in the ancient times. Afternoon continue on to the **Summer Palace** – It is the best kept existing Royal Garden in Beijing where the Imperial Families of the Qing Dynasty handled their official affairs, spent their summer, celebrated their birthdays or simply retreat to some relaxation. Then visit the **Beijing Olympic Site : The National Stadium**, known as the **Bird's Nest**, serve as the Main venue of the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games. It stretches 333 meters from North to South and 298 meters from East to West. It is 68 meters high and hold 91,000 seats. The blue-colored National Aquatics Center (NAC), nicknamed the "**Water Cube**" is located on the Southern part of the central area of the Olympic Green in Beijing. The construction area is close to 80,000 square meters, containing 17,000 standard seats, including 6,000 permanent and 11,000 temporary seats. Dinner will be provided. After dinner, it will be followed by acrobatic show in the evening. Overnight stay at **Novotel Xinqiao Beijing Hotel** or similar class.

Day 03 BEIJING – TIANANMEN SQUARE, FORBIDDEN CITY, TEMPLE OF HEAVEN

(B/L/D)

Breakfast in the hotel. Today we will begin with our full day tour of Beijing including visit to the **Tiananmen Square, The Forbidden City** and **The Temple of Heaven** with lunch en route at local restaurant. The **Tiananmen Square** in the Center of Beijing was built in 1651. It is said to be the biggest public square in the World. It is 880 meters from North to South and 500 meters from East to West and can hold one million people. Lying in the Center of Beijing is the **Forbidden City** which used to be the Imperial Palace of the Ming and Qing Dynasties. It is the largest ancient architectural structure in China where 24 emperors of the Ming and Qing Dynasty ascended to the throne and ruled over 500 years. Finally visit **The Temple of Heaven** where the Ming and Qing Emperors went to worship and pray for a good harvest. Peking Duck Dinner in the evening. Overnight stay at **Novotel Xinqiao Beijing Hotel** or similar class.

Day 04 BEIJING / SHANGHAI

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning free time until coach transfer out to the airport for your departure flight to **Shanghai**. After forty years of stagnation, the great metropolis of Shanghai is currently undergoing one of the fastest economic expansions that the world has ever seen. While shops overflow and the skyline fills with skyscrapers, Shanghai now seems certain to recapture its position as East Asia's leading business city, a status it last held before World War II. And yet, for all the modernization Shanghai has retained deep links with its colonial past.

Upon arrival, meet by local representative and transfer to the hotel for check in. Lunch and Dinner will be provided at local restaurant. After dinner, proceed with our **Huangpu River Night Cruise**. The Huángpu River (Huángpu Jiang) is the city's shipping artery both to the East China Sea and to the mouth of the Yángzi River, which the Huángpu joins 29km (18 miles) north of downtown Shànghai. It has also become a demarcating line between two Shànghais, east and west, past and future. Overnight stay at **Majesty Plaza Hotel** or similar class.

Day 05 SHANGHAI

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning begin with our sightseeing tour including visit to the **Yu Garden**, located at the heart of Old Town, a few blocks southwest of the **Bund** in downtown Shanghai. It is one of China's loveliest private classical gardens. It is indeed a pastoral world apart from modern and hectic Shanghai. Lunch at local restaurant. After lunch continue visit to **The Bund** which means the Embankment refers to Shanghai's famous waterfront running along the west shore of the 114-kilometer **Huangpu River** (a tributary of Yangtze River), forming the eastern boundary of old downtown Shanghai. Today it consists of a marvelous promenade, stretching from Suzhou Creek in the north to Jinling Lu in the south, the perfect platform for strolling along the busy river. Just across the wide avenue (Zhongshan Dong Yi Lu) that parallels the promenade is Shanghai's signature city scape, a long wall of colonial-era European buildings erected by foreign governments, trading houses, and expatriate millionaires mostly during the prosperous and notorious 1920s and 1930s. Nanjing Road, the so-called No.1 shopping street on the Chinese mainland which is being developed into a world class commercial destination. **Nanpu Bridge, Pearl of the Orient TV Tower**, 468-meter-high and Pudong Area. Evening Oriental TV Tower Buffet Dinner. Return to hotel. Overnight stay at **Majesty Plaza Hotel** or similar class.

Day 06 SHANGHAI / MANILA

(B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel, Morning free time for own leisure. Lunch at local restaurant. Then afternoon, coach transfer out to the airport for your departure flight back to Manila.
