


EASTERN EUROPE (14) DAYS TOUR

(Visit: Poland, Hungary, Austria, Slovakia, & Czech Republic)



Itinerary:

DAY 01 MANILA / WARSAW

Assemble at the airport for your departure flight to **WARSAW** – 8TH biggest city in the European Union and Capital of Poland. Overnight on board.

DAY 02 WARSAW ARRIVAL

(L/D)

Upon arrival in the airport, meet by our local representative and transfer for lunch at Chinese Restaurant. After Lunch, check in hotel. Balance of the afternoon is free time for rest and leisure. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight at **Hilton Hotel** or similar class.

DAY 03 WARSAW

(B/L/D)

Hot buffet breakfast in the hotel. Morning begin our city tour of **Warsaw**. The city was almost totally destroyed during World War II and only the amazing amount of detail in Canaletto's paintings of the city allowed the authentic reconstruction we see today. We will visit the emotive **Ghetto Heroes Monument** and the **Chopin Memorial Park** before seeing the "Wedding Cake" Palace of Culture and the **Neoclassical Lazienki Palace** with lunch en-route. Afternoon continue to **Zelazowa Wola** for a visit to Chopin's Birth place with tour ending at restaurant for Polish dinner with folklore show. Overnight at **Hilton Hotel** or similar class.

DAY 04 WARSAW / CZESTOCHOWA / KRAKOW

(B/L/D)

Hot buffet breakfast in the hotel. Morning transfer by long distance will take us south to **Czestochowa**. This is the site of 14th Century Paulite Monastery at Jasna Gora. Tour including entrance to **Jasna Gora Monastery**, a famous Polish shrine to the Virgin Mary and one of the country's places of pilgrimage – for many the monastery is a spiritual capital. The image of the **Black Madonna of Czestochowa**, also known as Our Lady of Czestochowa, to which miraculous powers are attributed, is one of Jasna Góra's most precious treasures. Lunch enroute at local restaurant. Afternoon continue drive to **Krakow** (approx 2.30 hrs – one of the largest and oldest cities in Poland. Upon arrival, check in at **Novotel Hotel** or similar class. Dinner at the hotel.

DAY 05 KRAKOW / OSWIECIM / WIELICZKA / KRAKOW

(B/L/D)

Hot Buffet Breakfast at the hotel. Today we will proceed with our full day sightseeing tour of Krakow, for centuries the seat of **Poland's Kings** and more recently the hometown of Pope John Paul II. Krakow is listed by the United Nations as one of the world's most significant historical sites. We will depart for **Oswiecim** (Auschwitz). The town is commonly known as being the location of the **Auschwitz Concentration Camp** (less commonly known as KL or KZ Auschwitz Birkenau) during World War II when Poland was under the control of Nazi Germany. Tour including entrance to **Auschwitz and Birkenau Concentration Camp**. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon continue to Wieliczka including entrance with lift to **Wieliczka Salt Mine and Salt Mine Museum** – one of the world's oldest operating salt mines. After the tour, transfer back to Krakow. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at **Novotel Hotel** or similar class.

DAY 06 KRAKOW / BUDAPEST (HUNGARY)

(B/L/D)

Hot buffet breakfast in the hotel. Morning visit the **Medieval Krakow Cloth Hall**. Then we ascent to **Wawel Hill** including **Entrance to Zamek Wawelski Cathedral (Wawel Castle)** and **Entrance to St. Mary's Church**. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon continue long distance coach drive to **Budapest** – Capital of Hungary. Upon arrival, check in and dinner at hotel. Overnight at **Radisson Blu Benke Hotel** or similar class.

DAY 07 BUDAPEST / DANUBE CRUISE / BUDAPEST

(B/L/D)

Hot buffet breakfast in the hotel. Morning begin our sightseeing tour including **Entrance to Fisherman's Bastion, Entrance to St. Stephen's Basilika, St. Matthias Church, Gellert Bath** and **photostop at Heroes Square**. After lunch at local restaurant, transfer to the pier for an hour of **Danube Cruise** with refreshment. Cruise ending at pier and then transfer to downtown free for shopping. Then proceed for local dinner with folklore show or gypsy music. Transfer back to **Radisson Blu Benke Hotel** or similar class for overnight stay.

DAY 08 BUDAPEST / BRATISLAVA (SLOVAKIA) / VIENNA (AUSTRIA)

(B/L/D)

Hot buffet breakfast in the hotel. Morning depart for **Bratislava** (approx 3 hrs) – Capital of Slovakia. Bratislava is located south western of Slovakia, occupying both banks of the **River Danube** and the left bank of River Morava. Bordering Austria and Hungary, it is the only national capital that borders two sovereign states. Upon arrival, lunch at local restaurant.

After lunch, proceed with short sightseeing with **Entrance to Courtyard only in Bratislavsky Hrad (Bratislava Castle)** and **photostop at Old Town Hall**. Continue to **Imperial Vienna** - Capital of Austria. En-route dinner at local restaurant in Grinzing. After dinner, transfer to hotel for check in. Overnight stay at **Courtyard By Marriot Hotel** or similar class.

DAY 09 VIENNA / HINTERBRUHL – SEEGROTTE / VIENNA

(B/L/D)

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning city tour including **Entrance to Schonbrunn Palace (Grand Tour)**, former Imperial summer residence. The 1,441-room **Baroque palace** is one of the most important architectural, cultural, and historical monuments in the country. Next view of **Hofburg Palace** and **Entrance to St. Stephans Cathedral**, the Mother church of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Vienna. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon, proceed with our half day excursion to **Hinterbruhl** including **Entrance to Seegrotte (Underground Lake)**. Dinner at local restaurant. Transfer back to hotel. Overnight at **Courtyard By Marriot Hotel** or similar class.

DAY 10 VIENNA / CESKY KRUMLOV / PRAGUE

(B/L/D)

Hot buffet breakfast in the hotel. Morning transfer for half day excursion to **Cesky Krumlov**, one of the most beautiful cities of the Czech Republic. Upon arrival, lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon begin sightseeing with Entrance to **Krumlov Castle (Zamek)** with castle guide and Entrance to **Cesky Krumlov CastIt Tower**. After visit, continue drive to **Prague** – Capital and largest city of the Czech Republic. It is the 14th largest city in the European Union and also the historical Capital of Bohemia. Transfer to hotel for check in. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay at **Marriott Hotel** or similar class.

DAY 11 PRAGUE

(B/L/D)

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning proceed with our full day city tour. It is ideal to see Prague with its new air of freedom since the “Velvet Revolution” but with its unique character still unchanged. Sightseeing including Entrance to **Prague Castle (Old Royale Palace including Vladislav Hall, St. Georges Basilica, Golden Lane with Daliborka Tower and St. Vitus Cathedral)**, Entrance to **Loreta**. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon continue tour with Entrance to **Church of St. Mary the Victorious and Old Town Square**. Balance of the afternoon for free time shopping at **Fashion Area Prague Outlet**. Folklore Show with dinner. Overnight stay at **Marriott Hotel** or similar class.

DAY 12 PRAGUE / KARLOVY VARY / PRAGUE

(B/L/D)

Hotel buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning long distance coach drive to **Karlovy Vary** (approx. 2.5 hrs). It is difficult to resist the worry free and ceremonial feeling of strolling on the quiet promenade between the ornate facades of Noble house, among the columns of richly decorated colonnades. Photostop at Beer Spa followed by visit to **Diana Hill Look Out Tower** with return ticket for Diana Funicular. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon continue tour with Entrance to **Moser Glass factory** (guided tour Glassworks by factory guide). Return to Prague. Dinner at Local Restaurant. Overnight at **Marriott Hotel** or similar class.

DAY 13 PRAGUE / MANILA

(B)

Hot Buffet Breakfast at the hotel. Free until transfer out to the airport for your flight back to Manila. Overnight on board.

DAY 14 ARRIVAL MANILA

Arrive Manila.
