

ARGENTINA VISA REQUIREMENTS:



VISA APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

STEP 1

Before applying for your visa to Argentina, applicants should decide the visa under which they wish to apply. Print the relevant list of requirements that corresponds with your application, complete and submit your documents to the Consular Section within the lodging hours. Complete and sign your application form and attach your photograph. Applications that are incomplete or incorrect will not be accepted.

STEP 2

Once your documents has been accepted, organize visa fees in the form of bank deposit payable to the account name and number provided by the Consular Section of the Embassy of Argentina. Other forms of visa fee will not be accepted. Payments made do not guarantee the granting of the visa, the decision will be made on the basis of the documents submitted.

STEP 3

Your visa may require supporting documents. After the assessment you will be given a period to comply for the additional documents. Bring the documents or email it to the Consular Section for the next round of assessment. To avoid delays all supporting documents should be submitted at the time of application.

STEP 4

You will receive a call or an email at least after ten (10) working days for the schedule of your visa interview. Bring your original passport, and the original documents (if applicable). Your passport will be available after two (2) working days. Other Important Information:

- Please ensure that your application form and photo meets the requirements. Failure to provide the correct documents will delay your visa processing and false information may derive in expulsion and re-entry ban.
- Name that appears in the documents should be in accordance to the passport of the applicant and written in FULL TEXT. Photo should be in accordance to the following specifications:

Acceptable:

- Photo is recent and reflects the current appearance, clear and in color, reproduces skin tones accurately and is properly exposed with no shadows.
- Photo clearly identifies the subject. Photo should be 4x4 cm (40 x 40 mm) or passport size with the head centered and about 80% of the whole photo size.
- Head is directly facing the camera with full-face view.
- Do not digitally enhance or alter the photo to change your appearance.
- Photo is sharp without any visible pixels or printed dots. Face should be in focus with neutral facial expression.
- Photo is taken in plain and white background, free of shadows and not cropped out using a photo retouching tools. For other nationalities other than Filipino, request for appropriate application form and fee at the Consular Section of the Embassy of the Argentine Republic in Manila.

VISA REQUIREMENT:



1. One (1) Duly accomplished application form (A4 sized paper)
2. One (1) recent 4x4 cm SIZE PHOTO or passport size
3. Valid passport & photocopy of the information pages
4. Letter of request from the applicant stating the reason for the travel, signed by the applicant with FULL NAME (MIDDLE NAME IN FULL TEXT)
5. Original and notarized Certificate of Employment indicating the following: full name, passport number, position, brief description of work duties, monthly salary & duration of leave. o If self employed, DTI Registration, SEC or Mayor's Permit, or Certificate and Articles of Incorporation and general information sheet for the current year.
6. Original Bank Certificate with corresponding Passbook or Bank Statement for the last three (3) months of the current year.
7. Detailed day to day itinerary.
8. Hotel Booking/s, from the hotel or online booking website (indicating the name of the applicant/s) or Letter of Invitation in Spanish from the contact in Argentina duly notarized and legalized by the College of Writers in Argentina (see instructions below).
9. Flight Booking/s, round trip ticket from the airline or website (indicating the name of the applicant/s)
10. For minors traveling alone, Affidavit of Support from parents, DSWD Permit (must be authenticated by the Department of Foreign Affairs), birth certificate and parent's government issued ID with picture(passport, Driver's License and other)
11. Other documents may be required as needed Letter of Invitation: Under the current immigration regulations, a foreigner traveling to the Argentine Republic for tourism and stays in the address of an Argentine resident, the host must execute a letter of invitation to send to the argentine consular authority abroad. The invitation letter serves the sole purpose of initiating the visa application process and does not guarantee, under any circumstances, the granting of visa abroad. The letter is informal and shall meet the following requirements:
 - It is written in Spanish.
 - Addressed to the intervening consular authority (E.g. Al Sr. Cónsul de la Republica en...).
 - Contain all personal and contact details of the inviting person in Argentina: name and surname, DNI, address, telephone or mobile number and email address.
 - Contain all personal and contact details of the foreigner invited to Argentina: name and surname, nationality, date of birth, type and passport number, telephone or mobile number, email address and any other contact details in the residence.
 - Explain the reason for traveling, relationship of the invited person with the host, duration of stay in the Republic, place of stay and estimated dates of arrival and departure.
 - Express that the signatory will be responsible for the departure of the said foreigner once the permitted length of stay expires.
 - Include the paragraph: "Como invitante de extranjeros, he leído y comprendo los términos de establecidos en el Capítulo VI de la Ley 25.871, artículos 116, 117, 118, 119, 120 y 121".
 - Contain the signature of the host, certified by the corresponding Notary Public and relevant Public Notaries Association.
 - Send the original, by post, to the Embassy of the Argentine Republic in Manila.
