

## EUROPE – BALKAN PENINSULA (14) DAYS TOUR

Countries Visited : Austria, Slovenia, Croatia, Bosnia & Herzegovina

Cities Visited : Vienna, Bled, Ljubljana, Plitvice National Park, Dubrovnik, Split , Mostar, Sarajevo, Zagreb,

### Itinerary:

#### **DAY 01 MANILA / VIENNA (AUSTRIA)**

Assemble at the International airport for your departure flight to Vienna (**Austria**). Overnight on board.

#### **DAY 02 ARRIVAL VIENNA**

(L.D.)

Upon arrival at the Vienna International Airport, meet by local representative and proceed with tour to **Schonbrunn Palace** including entrance, a former Imperial 1,441 room Rococo Summer residence in modern Vienna. View of the **State Opera** and view of **Hofburg Palace**. Then proceed with lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon continue tour with entrance to **St. Stephens Cathedral** (tower not included). Dinner at the hotel. Check in at **Hilton Hotel** or similar class.

#### **DAY 03 VIENNA / VIENNA WOODS / VIENNA**

(B.L.D.)

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning long distance coach for half day excursion to **Vienna Woods**, a forested highlands that form the northeastern foothills of the **Northern Limestone Alps** in the states of Lower Austria and Vienna. Entrance to the **Seagrotto** with guided tour. Lunch at Chinese restaurant. Afternoon half day at own disposal or leisure or shopping. Dinner provided at local restaurant. Overnight at **Hilton Hotel** or similar class.

#### **DAY 04 VIENNA / GRAZ / BLEED (SLOVENIA)**

(B.L.D.)

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning begin our long distance coach transfer to **Graz** for orientation tour. **Graz** is the second-largest city in Austria after Vienna and the capital of the federal state of Styria (Steiermark). It has a long tradition as a student city: its six universities have more than 44,000 students. It's "Old Town" is one of the best -preserved city centres in Central Europe. Lunch at local restaurant. Then continue on to **Bled (Slovenia)**. Bled is an Alpine town along side glacial Lake Bled in North Western Slovenia. It is most notable as a popular tourist destination in the Upper Carniola region and in Slovenia as whole. Dinner at the hotel. Check in **Park Hotel** or similar class.

#### **DAY 05 BLEED / POSTOJNA / BLEED**

(B.L.D.)

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning proceed with our half day excursion to **Postojna**, a town in the traditional region of Inner Carniola, 35 kilometers (22 mi) from Trieste, in South Western Slovenia. It is the seat of the Municipality of Postojna. Sightseeing including entrance to **Postojna Caves** with truck ride. (reminder: warm clothes are needed inside the caves, constant temperature of 8 -10°C and need to walk up and down approximately 1.5 km). Lunch at local restaurant. Then continue with half day tour with visit to **St. Maria's Church** including boat ride to the Island and entrance to the **Bled Castle**. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at **Park Hotel** or similar class.



Mostar

#### **DAY 06 BLEED / LJUBLJANA / PLITVICE NATIONAL PARK (CROATIA)**

(B.L.D.)

Hot buffet breakfast at hotel. Morning long distance coach transfer to **Ljubljana**. It is the capital and largest city of Slovenia. Half day sightseeing tour including view of the **Parliament Building**, entrance to the City Hall, view of **Ljubljana Castle** (no coach access, must take steep 20 mins uphill walk). Lunch at local restaurant. Then continue on to **Plitvice National Park (Croatia)**, approximately 200 kms – 3:50 hours. Upon arrival, check in to **Jezero Hotel** or similar class. Dinner at the hotel.



Zagreb

#### **DAY 07 PLITVICE NATIONAL PARK / SPLIT**

(B.L.D.)

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning enjoy half day sightseeing tour with entrance to **Plitvice National Park** including shuttle bus and boat ride. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon continue travel through scenic Croatian countryside to Split, the largest city in Dalmatia and the second largest city of Croatia sightseeing begin with entrance to **Diocletian's Palace** including peristyle/cellar room. Entrance to **Cathedral St. Dujce** including **St. Lucy's Crypt** and **Temple of Jupiter**. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay at **Radisson Blu Resort** or similar class.

**DAY 08 SPLIT / DUBROVNIK****(B.L.D.)**

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning travel along the coast to **Dubrovnik**. It is also known as Ragusa a city on the Adriatic Sea Coast of Croatia. In 1979 the city of Dubrovnik joined the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites. Lunch at local restaurant. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay at **Ariston Hotel** or similar class.

**DAY 09 DUBROVNIK****(B.L.D.)**

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Today begin our full day sightseeing tour with visit to the **Franciscan Monastery** including the Old Pharmacy. Entrance to the **Dominican Monastery and Museum**, entrance to the **Top of the City Walls**. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon continue tour with entrance to the Rector's Palace, stop at panoramic view point Orsula for view of Dubrovnik. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at **Ariston Hotel** or similar class.

**DAY 10 DUBROVNIK / MOSTAR / SARAJEVO (BOSNIA & HERZEGOVINA)****(B.L.D.)**

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning travel from the **Dalmatian Coast** and the spectacular city of **Dubrovnik to Mostar**. Upon arrival city tour to see the magnificent bridge at **Mostar**. This city grew up around a trade and bridging point over this old bridge, the **"Stari Most"**, built by Sinan the great Ottoman Architect and one of Bosnia and Heregovina's most recognizable landmarks. Destroyed during the war it has been rebuilt using the same methods as during the 16th century. Free time to explore the town. Lunch at local restaurant.

Afternoon continue on towards **Sarajevo**. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay at **Radon Plaza Hotel** or similar class.

**DAY 11 SARAJEVO / ZAGREB (CROATIA)****(B.L.D.)**

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning city tour of **Sarajevo**. Due to its rich religious and cultural history Sarajevo is often called the Jerusalem of Europe. The city contains Synagogues, mosques, orthodox as well as catholic churches – all in one city. In 1914 the city was the site of the **Assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand** which promoted the start of the First World War. Then tour of the Sarajevo **War Tunnels**. The **Sarajevo Tunnel** was constructed by the Bosnian Army in order to link the city of Sarajevo, which was entirely cut-off by Serbian Forces. The tunnel allowed food, war supplies and humanitarian aid to come into the city and people to get out. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon continue travel to **Zagreb – Croatia**. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay at **Hilton Hotel** or similar class.

**DAY 12 ZAGREB****(B.L.D.)**

Hot buffet breakfast at hotel. Begin our tour of **Zagreb(Croatia)**, the capital and the largest city of the Republic of Croatia. Walk through the stone gate and visit to the **Little Chapel of Our Lady of the Stone Gate**. Outside view of **St. Mark's Church**. Entrance to funicular railway and entrance to **Lotrscak Tower** – it is a fortified tower located in old part of town called **Gradec or Gornji** grad which dates to the 13th century and built to guard the Southern gate of the Gradec town wall. Lunch and dinner provided at local restaurant. Overnight at **Hilton or Westin Hotel** or similar class.

**DAY 13 ZAGREB / MANILA****(B.)**

Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning free time until check out from hotel and transfer to airport for flight back to Manila. Overnight on board.

**DAY 14 ARRIVAL MANILA**

Arrival Manila with fond memories of Europe Balkan Peninsula. Welcome back home.
