DAY 01 MANILA / AUCKLAND

Assemble at the airport for departure flight to **AUCKLAND** – In the North Island of New Zealand, is the largest and most populous urban area in the country. Meet by local representative upon arrival and coach transfer to hotel for check in. Overnight in **Sky City Grand Hotel, Auckland** or similar class.

DAY 02 AUCKLAND / MATAMATA / ROTORUA

(B/L/D)

Cooked breakfast will be provided. Morning depart for **Matamata** including **Hobbiton Movie Set Tour**. It is a rural town nestled at the base of the scenic Kaimai Ranges. It is well known for its thoroughbred industry, daily farming heritage and historic firth tower museum. Since the launch of the Lord of the Rings Movies and subsequent opening of the Hobbiton Movie Set Tour, Matamata has become a vibrant visitor destination. Lunch provided en-route. Then coach depart for **Rotorua**, a major destination for both domestic and international tourists. Enjoy **Agrodome Eco Farm** and **Orchard Tour** where you will have the chance to feed the animals. Explore the fruit orchard and have the chance to taste natural kiwifruit juice and delicious sweet honey. In the evening, you will be escorted to the dining hall for **Hangi Dinner** (The Maori way of cooking) including Maori concert. Overnight at **Millennium Hotel, Rotorua** or similar class.

DAY 03 ROTORUA / TE PUIA / WAITOMO / AUCKLAND

(B/L/D)

Cooked breakfast will be served at the hotel restaurant, Morning enjoy a guided tour of **Te Puia** – The premier Māori cultural centre in New Zealand, where you can learn the art and the history of Maori People. It is a place of gushing waters, steaming vents, boiling mud pools and spectacular geysers. Te Puia is home to world renowned **Pohutu geyser and Te Whakarewarewa geothermal valley**, the National Carving and Weaving Schools. Then visit **Rainbow Springs Nature Park** where you can see New Zealand's native wildlife and unique **Flora and Fauna** including Kiwi Bird. Coach depart for Waitomo. BBQ lunch enroute. Afternoon proceed with guided tour of **Waitomo Glow Worm Caves** where we will experience the beauty of the world famous Glow Worm Grotto. The glow worm, is unique to New Zealand. Thousands of these tiny creatures radiate their unmistakable luminescent light as our expert guides provide informative commentary on the Caves' historical and geological significance. After the tour, continue to **Auckland city**. Dinner provided at local restaurant. Check in and overnight at **Sky City Grand Hotel, Auckland** or similar class.

DAY 04 AUCKLAND / QUEENSTOWN

(B/L/D)

Cooked breakfast in the hotel. Morning check out from hotel and continue tour with admission to **Sky Tower** for a panoramic view of Auckland. Then check in at Pier 1 for a 12 mins ferry ride from Auckland to **Devonport Ferry** where lies Devonport seaside village – The picturesque historic village boasts stunning views of Auckland city unseen from any other location. Buffet lunch at Fortuna Restaurant or similar. Afternoon commence for Auckland city sightseeing including **Mission Bay, Michael Joseph Salvage Memorial Park, Auckland Domain, Parnell Village, View of Harbour Bridge** and driving pass **Queen Street**, etc. Then transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to **Queenstown** - a resort town in Otago in the south-west of New Zealand's South Island and a centre for adventure tourism and snow sports in New Zealand. Upon arrival, meet and transfer for Western set dinner. Check in and overnight at **Novotel Queenstown Lakeside** or similar class.

DAY 05 QUEENSTOWN / MILFORD SOUND / TE ANAU / QUEENSTOWN

(B/L/D)

Cooked breakfast at the hotel. Morning coach for scenic **Milford Sound** day excursion with visit to Te Anau enroute. Highlights include **Te Anau : Eglinton Valley** – ancient alpine beech forest, stunning waterfalls ; **Mirror Lakes** – photo opportunity ; Homer Tunnel ; Fiordland national Park. Enjoy **Milford Scenic Cruise** with International buffet lunch on board. Then coach return to Queenstown. Dinner in hotel or similar. Overnight at **Novotel Queenstown Lakeside** or similar class.

DAY 06 QUEENSTOWN

(B/L/D)

Cooked breakfast in the hotel. Then morning departs for **Steamer Wharf** and board **TSS EARNSLAW, Queenstown** iconic vintage steamship for Walter Peak. TSS Earnslaw is the last surviving and grandest steamship to have ever graced **Lake Wakatipu** and named after **Mount Earnslaw** - the highest peak in the region. Cruise across the lake and disembark to a warm kiwi welcome and enjoy an exciting farm show and have a taste of New Zealand's farming lifestyle at Walter Peak Farm followed by BBQ lunch at homestead. Afternoon arrive back to the Steamer Wharf and coach transfer to **Gibbston Valley** and enjoy a guided wine cave tour at **Gibbston Valley Winery**. After the tour, visit **AJ Hackett Bungy** and you will have a chance to experience the Bungy Jump on own expenses. Then visit historic **Gold Mining Village** – Arrow town and guest can join optional Shotover Jet boat ride by own expenses. Then take a gondola ride up to **Bob's Peak at Skyline** for a beautiful panoramic view of Queenstown followed by buffet dinner. Overnight at **Novotel Queenstown Lakeside** or similar class.

DAY 07 QUEENSTOWN / MT. COOK / TEKAPO / CHRISTCHURCH

(B/L/D)

Cooked breakfast will be served at the hotel restaurant. Morning depart by coach to **Mt. Cook Village** via Cromwell. Make a brief stop at **Mrs. Jones Orchard** (each guest will received 1 kg of seasonal fruits). Then coach journey to **Omarama** – a small township and is Maori for "Place of Light", a reference to its extraordinarily pure and clear sky for buffet lunch. After lunch, continue to **Mt. Cook Village** with photo stops at **Lake Pukaki Lookout Point**. Optional scenic flight is available at **Glentannar** (subject to weather conditions and at own expense). Continue to Tekapo with photo stops at **Lake Tekapo**, the country's highest large lake (710 m above sea level), **Church of Good Shepherd** – the first church to be built in the Mackenzie Basin (1935). Group may drop by Farmers corner for local souvenir en-route (if time permits). Continue to **Christchurch**. Check in hotel. Dinner at local restaurant Overnight at **Rydges Latimer Hotel, Christchurch** or similar class.

DAY 08 CHRISTCHURCH / AUCKLAND / MANILA

(B/L)

Cooked breakfast will be served at the hotel restaurant. Morning check out from hotel and commence Christchurch sightseeing including **Avon River, Hagley Park, Cashmere Hills and Botanical Garden**. Enjoy a 30 minutes punting on the Avon experience followed by buffet lunch. Then proceed with short visit to the **International Antarctic Center** followed by **Canterbury Museum** (donation is recommended). Late afternoon transfer to domestic airport to take the flight to **Auckland**. Upon arrival at Auckland Domestic Airport, transfer to the International Airport to check in for your flight back to Manila. Dinner at own arrangement. Overnight on board.

DAY 09 AUCKLAND / MANILA

Arrival Manila bringing home fond memories of **New Zealand**.
