

Itinerary:

DAY 01 MANILA / TOKYO

(D)

Assemble at the airport for departure to **TOKYO**. Upon arrival at the airport, meet by local representative and transfer to the Hotel for check in. Dinner provided at local restaurant. Overnight stay at **Grand Nikko Tokyo Daiba** or similar class.

DAY 02 TOKYO

(B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning Tokyo City sightseeing tour including visit to the **Imperial Palace**, where the Japanese Royal Family resides. It is surrounded by moats and massive stone walls. You will enjoy a walk in the beautiful garden. Then visit **Asakusa Kannon Temple**. It is Tokyo's Oldest and largest Buddhist Temple. The busy shopping street leading from the Kaminarimon gate to the Temple is the covered **Nakamise Arcade or Nakamise Shopping Street** selling all sorts of Buddhist paraphernalia as well as assorted tourist kitsch. This is one of the best places in Tokyo to buy souvenirs. Next visit **Tokyo Tower** - symbol of Tokyo with 333 meters. Enjoy the panoramic view from Main Observatory. After visiting Tokyo tower, free time for shopping. Yakiniku lunch or similar. Dinner at own arrangement. Overnight stay at **Grand Nikko Tokyo Daiba** or similar class.

DAY 03 TOKYO DISNEYLAND OR TOKYO DISNEY SEA

(B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Today proceed with whole day tour of **TOKYO DISNEY RESORT**. It is a theme park and vacation resort located in Urayasu, Chiba, Japan, just east of Tokyo. The resort opened on April 15, 1983, as a single theme park (Tokyo Disneyland), but developed into a resort with two theme parks namely Tokyo Disneyland and Tokyo Disney Sea, three Disney hotels and a shopping complex.

(We will visit 1 theme park only and you have the option to choose either from TOKYO DISNEYLAND or TOKYO DISNEY SEA. In case you want to visit 2 theme parks, then you have to buy the extra theme park 1 day ticket at your own expenses.)

Lunch at own arrangement. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight stay at **Grand Nikko Tokyo Daiba** or similar class.

DAY 04 TOKYO / MT. FUJI / HAKONE / TOYOHASHI OR HAMAMATSU

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning excursion to **Mt. Fuji** which is the highest and most beautiful Mountain in Japan. Drive up to the 5th station 8,000 foot high and enjoy the magnificent view of the scenery and of surrounding lakes and mountains **(If weather permits)**. Buffet Lunch at Kogen Beer Restaurant. After Lunch, enjoy ropeway ride to **Owakudani Hell Valley** and take the leisurely cruise on **Lake Ashi**. Owakudani Hell Valley is a volcanic valley with active sulphur vents and hot springs in Hakone, Kanagawa Prefecture, Japan. It is a popular tourist site for its scenic views, volcanic activity, and especially, Kuro-tamago (black egg) — a local specialty of eggs hard-boiled in the hot springs. Late afternoon, transfer to Toyohashi or Hamamatsu. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight at **Loisir Hotel Toyohashi or Hamamatsu Okura Hotel** or similar class.

DAY 05 TOYOHASHI / KYOTO / OSAKA

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning Transfer to **Kyoto** by coach and begin with the day tour of Kyoto City. **Kiyomizu Temple** is Kiyomizudera is one of the most celebrated temples of Japan. It was founded in 780 on the site of the Otowa Waterfall in the wooded hills east of Kyoto, and derives its name from the fall's pure waters.

The temple was originally associated with the Hosso sect, one of the oldest schools within Japanese Buddhism, but formed its own Kita Hosso sect in 1965. In 1994, the temple was added to the list of UNESCO world heritage sites. Then visit Sanjusangendo. this is the popular name for Rengeo-in, a temple in eastern Kyoto which is famous for its 1001 statues of Kannon, the goddess of mercy. The temple was founded in 1164 and rebuilt a century later after the original structure had been destroyed in a fire. Transfer from Kyoto Station to Shin Osaka by bullet train and check in hotel. Lunch and dinner provided. Overnight stay at **Hilton Osaka** or similar class.

DAY 06 OSAKA / NARA / OSAKA

(B/L)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning transfer to **Todaiji**, one of Japan's most famous and historically significant temples and a landmark of Nara. The Temple was constructed in 752 as the head temple of all provincial Buddhist temples of Japan and grew so powerful that the capital was moved from Nara to Nagaoka in 784 in order to lower the temple's influence on government affairs. Then visit **Nara Park**, Established in 1880, it is the location of many of Nara's main attractions including Todaiji, Kasuga Taisha, Kofukuji and the Nara National Museum. It is also home to hundreds of freely roaming deer. Deer crackers are for sale around the park, and some deer have learned to bow to visitors to ask to be fed. Afternoon is free time for own leisure or do some shopping in **Shinsaibashi, Namba shopping area**. Buffet lunch or similar. Dinner at own arrangement. Overnight stay at **Hilton Osaka** or similar class.

DAY 07 OSAKA / UNIVERSAL STUDIOS / OSAKA

(B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Today begin with full day tour of "**Universal Studios Japan**". It is the legendary entertainment company's first studio theme park outside of the United States. Its spectacular movie theme shows and attraction will place guests in the heart of the World of American Motion Pictures and Television. Universal Studios Japan currently has nine sections: Hollywood, New York, San Francisco, Jurassic Park, Waterworld, Amity Village, Universal Wonderland, The Wizarding World of Harry Potter and new opened area "Minion Park". Fully immerse yourself in the world of unique and adorable Minions with the opening of the world's largest Minion Mayhem area! Supervillain Gru, the Minions' boss, lives in this peaceful area. Lunch on your own arrangement. Buffet Dinner at Universal Port Hotel or similar. Overnight stay at **Hotel Nikko Kansai Airport** or similar class.

DAY 08 OSAKA / MANILA

(B)

Breakfast in the hotel. Morning free time until check out from hotel and proceed to Kansai Airport in time for your departure flight back to Manila.
