Itinerary:

DAY 01 MANILA / JOHANNESBURG

Assemble at the airport for your departure flight to **JOHANNESBURG** – The economic hub of South Africa and increasingly for the rest of Africa. Overnight on board.

DAY 02 ARRIVAL JOHANNESBURG / PRETORIA / SUN CITY

(L/D)

Early morning arrival at the Johannesburg International Airport. After clearing immigration and custom, you will be meet by our local representative and proceed to **Pretoria** for a brief city tour – The administrative capital of South Africa and renowned for its colorful gardens, shrubs and trees. Your city tour will bring you to visit historical sites such as the **Voortrekker Monument** which dominates the Pretoria skyline. You will also drive pass the **Church Square and Union Buildings**. Today's lunch will be served at Chinese restaurant or local restaurant. After lunch, transfer to **SUN CITY** – Otherwise known as "The City That Never Sleeps". Upon arrival, check in to hotel. Rest of the day is free for own leisure. Tonight dinner will be served at Sun Terrace Restaurant in Sun City. Overnight stay at **Palace of the Lost City** or similar class.

DAY 03 SUN CITY / JOHANNESBURG

(B/L/D)

Early morning, set out in an open-top bush vehicles for a guided game drive with an opportunity to view and photograph the abundant wildlife at close range, while your ranger explains the animal's survival tactics in the wilderness. Return to the hotel for breakfast, after which, rest of the day is free at your own leisure. Today, you may discover the many myths and legends from Africa's distant past, which surround The Lost City, a photographer's dream come true with its magnificent ancient architecture and beautiful landscapes. For those who would like to try their luck in winnings, there are many casinos and jackpots available here. For sport enthusiasts, enjoy a game of golf at any one of the two championship courses here or try water sports of any form imaginable at Water World, a man-made lake (at own expense). An exciting day awaits you !! Lunch will be served at the hotel.

In the afternoon, travel back to **Johannesburg** and proceed to Cambanos for some souvenir shopping. In the evening proceed for dinner at the Carnivore located at Muldershiff, well known for its game meat. Enjoy a typical African meal at Carnivore restaurant. Celebrate with "Africa's Greatest Eating Experience", A Selection of succulent, charcoal grilled game and domestic meats, skewered onto Masai swords and cooked to perfection over an open fire. Eat as much as you like. We only stop when you put down your flag in surrender. Check in hotel. Overnight stay in **The Maslow Hotel or Sandton Sun** or similar class.

DAY 04 JOHANNESBURG / GOLD REEF CITY / JOHANNESBURG

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning proceed for a tour of **Golf Reef City** which is a reconstruction of Johannesburg during the Gold Rush Era built around a gold mine. Included in this tour is a descend down an old gold mine shaft to learn how gold was extracted in the past and get to witness molten gold being poured and watch exciting tribal dancing.

(Please be advised that visitors to the mine must be in good state of health, those with asthma, heart problems, walking difficulties and pregnant ladies are advised against going down for your own safety. Children below the age of five are not allowed to go down the mine at all. It is closed every Mondays and Tuesdays).

Today's lunch will be served at a Thai restaurant or local restaurant. Then continue tour to **Soweto Township**, the site of the tragic 1976 riots. Despite its crowded, chaotic conditions, there is still a tangible sense of community in these neighborhoods that you cannot find in the orderly, walled suburbs. Entrance to Nelson Mandela House and Hector Peterson memorial included. Proceed for a photo stop outside the Soccer city stadium. Dinner will be served at Chinese/or local restaurant. Overnight at **The Maslow Hotel or Sandton Sun** or similar class.

DAY 05 JOHANNESBURG / CAPETOWN

(B/L/D)

After a leisurely breakfast at the hotel. Free time for own leisure. Proceed for some shopping at the Sandton Mall. Today lunch will be served at Chinese restaurant. After lunch, coach pick up transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to **Cape Town**.

Upon arrival in bustling Capetown – “The Fairest Cape of them all and meeting point of the Indian and Atlantic Oceans, meet and greet by local representative and transfer to western restaurant for dinner. Then check in at **AC Hotel by Marriott Cape Town Waterfront** or similar class for overnight stay.

DAY 06 CAPETOWN / CAPE PENINSULA / CAPETOWN

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, depart on a full day tour of the **Cape Peninsula**. This tour brings you to the Atlantic suburbs, Sea Point, Clifton and Camps Bay to Hout Bay, where you embark on a boat ride to Seal Island, (*if weather permits*). Continue on to Chapman’s Peak Drive, one of the most spectacular coastal roads in South Africa. It starts at the picturesque fishing harbor of Hout Bay and then winds up to Chapman’s Point, revealing breathtaking views of the sandy bays down below, until the road reaches sea level again at Noordhoek. Thereafter, continue on to Mineral World, a gemstone factory. A lobster lunch will then be served at the Fish Hoek Restaurant. After lunch, drive along False Bay to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve before reaching Cape Point, and ascend to the highest point with the funicular. Continue the tour driving into Boulders Beach and see the penguins. Drive past Simon’s Town, an old naval base, Muizenberg, Fish Hoek. Dinner provided. Overnight stay at **AC Hotel by Marriott Cape Town Waterfront or similar class**.

DAY 07 CAPETOWN

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, morning visit **Cheetah Outreach Center** in Somerset west which has made land available to a group of hand raised cheetahs in the care of the Cheetah Outreach Programme. Learn more about these incredible cats from a distance, or get up, close and personal and even step inside the enclosure. (**Note : Entrance fees only, personal encounter with the Cheetah is NOT INCLUDED**). Next continue with **Winelands Tour**. This is the perfect opportunity to stock-up your wine cellar as you can call on some of South Africa’s foremost wine estates. This includes visit to the city of Stellenbosch with backdrop of the Hollentots Holland Mountains, the white gabled Cape Dutch homesteads and the oak lined streets and lanes. Visit a wine estate for a cellar tour and wine tasting session. Lunch will be served in one of the wine estates. After lunch, continue to Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens beautifully situated on the eastern slopes of Table Mountain, and boasts some 6000 species of the indigenous plants of Southern Africa. If time permits, proceed for shopping at V & A Waterfront. Dinner at Chinese restaurant or similar. Overnight at **AC Hotel by Marriott Cape Town Waterfront** or similar class.

DAY 08 CAPETOWN

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed on a drive-by-city tour to the **Castle of Good Hope** – restored fort of Cape Town, The City Hall, The Houses of Parliament, the Historical Malay Quarters. Thereafter, transfer to the Cable Station where you will have the opportunity to reach the top of the world famous Table Mountain by cable car, (**If weather permits.**) Enjoy the crisp air and clear visibility as you savor what must be an experience of a lifetime. Visit Greenmarket Square, Capetown city’s most vibrant flea markets before we continue on to Cape Town Ostrich Ranch. Lunch in Ostrich Ranch. After lunch, proceed with a guided ostrich farm tour. Thereafter proceed to Century City – Africa’s largest shopping and entertainment center that was open in October 2000. It has more than 450 shops. Century City is not just another shopping mall, from its break taking architecture, design details and the sweep of its spacious malls, from the murals reflecting art through the ages of magnificent giant sculptures to the live and multi media entertainment. Tonight dinner will be served at local restaurant. Overnight stay at **AC Hotel by Marriott Cape Town Waterfront** or similar class.

DAY 09 CAPETOWN / MANILA

(B)

After breakfast, coach pick up group from hotel and transfer out to Cape Town International Airport for your departure flight back to Manila. Overnight on board.

DAY 10 ARRIVAL / MANILA

Arrive Manila with fond memories and souvenirs of South Africa not to be found elsewhere in the world!
