## Itinerary:

### **DAY 01** MANILA / COPENHAGEN (DENMARK)

Assemble at the International Airport for your departure flight to **Copenhagen** – The Capital of Denmark and the country's largest city. Overnight on board.

### **DAY 02** ARRIVAL COPENHAGEN

(L/D)

Early arrival in **Copenhagen**, you will be meet by our local guide for short tour of the city followed by lunch at local restaurant. After lunch, Check in at the hotel. Balance of the day is free time for own leisure or rest. Copenhagen is the premier capital of **Northern Europe**. The city is one of Europe's oldest capitals with a royal touch – the monarchy in Denmark is the oldest in the world! Dinner in the hotel. Overnight stay at **Radisson Blu Hotel** or similar class.

### **DAY 03** COPENHAGEN / OSLO (NORWAY)

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Check out from hotel and begin your sightseeing of the city by coach. View the impressive **Stock Exchange, the Medieval Cathedral, Amalienborg Palace** – Home of the **Royal Danish Monarchy** and **Christianborg Palace** – The seat of the Danish Parliament. Complete the day with view of **Hans Christian Anderson and Little Mermaid** at the Waterfront followed by Entrance to **Tivoli Gardens**, one of the best Amusement Park in the world (closed during winter season). Lunch at local restaurant. Late in the afternoon, you will board a modern cruise ship for the **overnight ferry** from Copenhagen to Oslo and enjoy a traditional Danish smorgasboard.

### **DAY 04** OSLO

(B/L/D)

Breakfast on board. A local guide will meet you at the harbour for a half day sightseeing tour of **Oslo** – The Capital and largest city of Norway. Highlight of the tour by motor coach includes visit to the beautiful **City Hall**, visit to **Oslo Cathedral** and Entrance to **Royal Palace**. the beautiful City Hall. Lunch at local restaurant. After lunch, free time for shopping. Check in and dinner at hotel. Overnight stay at **Radisson Blu Hotel** or similar class.

### **DAY 05** OSLO

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Then morning proceed with our whole day sightseeing tour including a live commentary in English and Norwegian Mini Cruise Tour. Entrance to the **Viking Ships Museum** and Entrance to **Akerhus Castle** and entrance to the Kontiki Museum. Lunch and dinner will be provided at local restaurant. Overnight stay at **Radisson Blu Hotel** or similar class.

### **DAY 06** OSLO / STOCKHOLM (SWEDEN)

(B/L/D)

Boxed breakfast, early morning transfer to station for 2nd class seat train ticket from **Oslo to Stockholm** – the Capital of Sweden and consequently the site of its Government and Parliament as well as the residence of the Swedish Head of State. The city is a fascinating mixture of sophistication and country life, a city of contrast between ancient and modern. Upon arrival, meet by assistant in the station. Proceed for lunch at local restaurant. After lunch, transfer to hotel for check in. Balance of the afternoon free time for own arrangement (shopping or rest). Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay at **Radisson Blu Hotel** or similar class.

**DAY 07 STOCKHOLM****(B/L/D)**

After breakfast, morning half day sightseeing tour which includes Entrance to the **Royal Palace**, Entrance to **Riddarholm Cathedral**, where the Swedish Kings are buried. Charming Medieval Old Town and the countless channels and bridges that connects this city's many island and Entrance to **Vasa Warship Museum**. Balance of the day is free for your own leisure. Lunch and Dinner will be provided. Overnight stay at **Radisson Blu Hotel** or similar class.

**DAY 08 STOCKHOLM / DROTTHINGHOLM / HELSINKI (FINLAND)****(B/L/D)**

Breakfast will be provided. Check out from hotel and morning half day excursion to **Drottingholm** (approx. 3.45 hrs) including Entrance to **Drottingholm Palace** – The private residence of the Swedish royal family with its preserved 182th Century theater which is still in use. The palace is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, mainly because of the **Palace Theatre and the Chinese Pavilion**. Lunch at city restaurant. Afternoon you will be transfer to the pier. Board a luxurious ship for an overnight ferry across the Baltic Sea to Finland. You can admire the scenic beauty of the Swedish Archipelago and the Baltic Sea. You can enjoy the merrymaking on the dance floor or have a good sleep in a comfortable cabin, awakening to find yourself approaching the Finnish Capital Helsinki. Dinner and **overnight on board**.

**DAY 09 HELSINKI****(B/L/D)**

Breakfast on board. Our guide will meet you at the harbor for a full day sightseeing tour of Helsinki including visit to **Sibelius Park and Sibelius Monument**, Entrance to **Tempeliaukio (Rock Church)**. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon continue tour with visit to **Helsinki Cathedral**, Entrance to **Finlandia Hall** with guided tour : View of **Finnish National Opera, National Museum, Parliament House, Senate Square, Sederholm House, National Library, University and Uspenski Orthodox Cathedral**. Dinner at local restaurant. Check in and overnight in **Radisson Blu Hotel** or similar class.

**DAY 10 HELSINKI / MANILA****(B)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Free time until transfer out to the airport for your flight back to Manila. Overnight on board.

**DAY 11 ARRIVAL MANILA**

Arrive Manila.
